

Curriculum Data Health Checklist



1. Data Centralization

Single Source of Truth

 All course objectives, session plans, and assessment items live in one platform or repository

Real-Time Updates

Changes to any map element immediately propagate to all downstream reports and dashboards

Search & Tagging

You can find any competency, course, or outcome via free-text search or standardized tags

2. Taxonomy & Governance

Controlled Vocabulary

 A published competency library exists and is enforced—no "synonyms" or local forks

Role-Based Permissions

 Each stakeholder (course director, program lead, accreditation officer) has the right level of read/write access

Version Control & Audit Trails

 Every change is timestamped, attributed, and easily revertible—so you're always audit-ready

3. Quality & Continuous Improvement

Mapping Completeness

O 100% of your courses have at least one linked learning outcome and one linked assessment

Gap & Redundancy Reports

You generate—on demand—reports that highlight uncovered outcomes and overlapping content

Review Cadence

You've defined (and scheduled) formal review cycles, with automatic notifications for overdue items

Stakeholder Feedback Loop

 Faculty and learners can submit mapping feedback that feeds directly back into your CQI process.
